

January 10th Update

Happy Sunday to you All!

Good afternoon all,

I just wanted to share the latest update for GRCCA classes.

As you may have heard - Griffin Spalding County Students will not return to Face to Face Instruction until February 1st. HOWEVER, that does not change the previous announcement for GRCCA classes - with the exception of Gordon State.

Please see the latest updates:

- A) All GRCCA classes - whether high school or SCTC will be REMOTE until Jan. 19th. Students need to login to their classes as follows:

1) GRCCA High School Classes begin Wednesday, January 6th - Aviation Flight Ops or Maintenance, Teaching as a Profession Practicum, Logistics and Distribution (Materials Management), Brit Lit VIRT, Am Lit VIRT, Intro to Careers VIRT, Careers VIRT. College Readiness Math VIRT, and US History VIRT.

Students need to sign into Google Classroom for classes, unless they say VIRT, then you will sign into Edgenuity for your online classes. Watch your email for access codes and information. Any class that has VIRT after it is an online class.

2) SCTC courses begin Monday, January 11th. Again, they are REMOTE until January 19th; after that time you have a choice of staying REMOTE or In Person (except lab classes, see below).

***REMOTE definition is logging into Blackboard during your class time - not just anytime you want - like an Online class.

Lab classes: Manufacturing, Welding, Healthcare, Auto, Film will move to IN PERSON and will not have a Virtual option. Criminal Justice and Cosmetology will need to check with their instructors and see if they have labs and when they must attend Face to Face.

GSCS students in lab classes - please send an email to grccaschedules2021@gmail.com if you need the bus to pick you up from home starting Jan. 19th to attend your face to face classes.

Biology class and Biology lab will only be REMOTE - they will not have a face to face option.

All SCTC students please sign into Blackboard the first day of your class. If you don't, you will be dropped and assigned a high school virtual class. Remember - you may only drop a class the first 3 days of the semester - if you drop after that - it is a withdrawal and compromises your future dual enrollment funding.

3) Gordon State Classes begin on Wednesday, January 25th and will meet on the GRCCA campus Face to Face. **GSCS students, if you need bus transportation for these classes, please send an email to grccaschedules2021@gmail.com and let us know.**

- B) Attendance will be taken daily and if you are not present Face to Face or on screen, you will be counted absent.
- C) Numerous students did not do well first semester - mainly because they did not attend virtual sessions and participate. Many courses require you to make a "C" or better to move to next semester. Some students failed courses or made a "D:" and are now ineligible for dual enrollment this semester. PLEASE, everyone needs to check their schedule for changes. If you are unable to see your schedule in Infinite Campus - you may send an email to grccaschedules2021@gmail.com and we will send you a copy.
- D) SCTC textbooks will be mailed to your address in Infinite Campus or Powerschools.
- E) Gordon textbooks may be picked up from the GRCCA from 10am-4pm on Tuesday, January 12th - Thursday, January 21st.
- F) The GRCCA is OPEN effective January 6th - January 18th for any student to come and login to your REMOTE classes, especially if you need to use the internet here or a chromebook. Effective January 19th, GRCCA will be open for Face to Face Instruction.
- G) Again this semester, all students attending Face to Face classes at the GRCCA will be required to wear a mask at all times, and have their temperature checked upon entry when Face to Face classes resume January 19th. If you are feeling sick - please do not come to campus - stay home.
