

Attention All GRCCA Students - there are changes to 2nd semester schedules as follows:

1) Please check your 2nd semester schedule after Monday, January 4th - as students that received a "D" or "F" may have schedule changes. Many courses require a "C" to continue on to the next level of courses or continue in the Dual Enrollment Program. Messages will be sent on Monday, January 4th at 5pm if your schedules was changed.

2) GRCCA High School Classes begin on Wednesday, January 6th. All courses will be VIRTUAL until Tuesday, January 19th. You must login to your class during the day and time of your class. Instructors will send out classroom codes to join the virtual class.

3) SCTC classes will begin on Monday, January 11th. These classes will also be virtual until January 19th. You must login to Blackboard the first day of class or you will be dropped from the class. Students must login virtually during every class time - or you will be withdrawn from the class. Keep in mind, withdrawals from dual enrollment classes will affect your dual enrollment funding.

After the 19th, students will have the opportunity to remain Virtual, or they may attend In Person.

****Note**** - lab classes will not have a virtual option after the 19th. Students must attend IN PERSON. This includes students in the Manufacturing, Welding, Auto, Film, or CNA programs. Cosmetology and Criminal Justice students will need to check with their instructors.

4) Gordon State classes will begin on Wednesday, January 13th. Any classes schedules to meet on the GRCCA campus will also be virtual until Tuesday, January 19th. Again, all students must login on the first day of class or you will be dropped. After the 19th, all Gordon classes will meet on the GRCCA campus IN PERSON.

5) JHS and PHS students may come to the GRCCA as early as January 6th. You will be able to stay in the Student Center and watch TV, read, etc. until your virtual classes begin. After that, you may participate in your Virtual Classes when scheduled. Chromebooks and internet will be available for student use.

6) Information on textbook distribution will be provided at a later date.
